Description

A wonderful late Victorian to early Edwardian bamboo hall stand, full of character and decorative interest. The central bevelled mirror is framed by a set of well made wrought iron faux bamboo coat and hat hooks. Beneath the mirror runs a striking panel of green-on-brown tiles, possibly by Minton, each featuring a lion rampant, a bold and unusual decorative touch that lifts the whole piece. Below sits a central cubby hole, likely once fitted with a small drawer, flanked on either side by three-compartment stick stands with their original bamboo divisions. The whole piece has the warmth, patina and slightly eccentric charm that make late-19th-century bamboo furniture so appealing. A distinctive and functional hall stand, ready to add style and personality to any entranceway. Table top height is 72cm. Width dimension is the total width including hooks.
