A pair of antique Italian walnut cupboard or cabinet doors, complete with their surrounding timber frame sections. Dating from the late 18th to early 19th century, these panels feature a classic single-panel configuration with traditional molded detailing. Constructed from dense, high-quality solid walnut, the timber retains a natural, stripped finish that clearly displays the wood grain. Both doors retain their original hand-forged iron barrel hinges although with some of the finials missing, iron keyhole escutcheons, and internal lock mechanisms. The central panels remain flat and true with no significant warping. The presence of the original outer frame sections makes this pair highly suitable for installation into built-in alcoves, bespoke libraries, or kitchen cabinetry. Good antique condition throughout. Structurally sound with age-related wear, light surface marks, and historic timber shrinkage consistent with age and use. No signs of active woodworm. One single original key that operates both locks. Dimensions, frame included: Height: 99 cm Width: 76 cm
