The slim proportions and long, elegant form give the piece a particularly versatile presence, ideal for use as a console table, serving table, kitchen dresser base or hallway piece. The top is formed from wide solid oak planks with excellent colour and patination, displaying the honest wear, movement and shrinkage expected from a piece of this age. Pegged construction, hand-worked timbers and visible joinery throughout all add to its authenticity and charm. A highly decorative and practical country antique with excellent depth of colour.
