Hallmarked for Sheffield, 1922. * The design reflects the enduring British taste for novelty silver, where practical objects were often given playful, elegant shapes. Measurements: Length: 2 3/4" (approx. 7cm) Silver weight: 16g In good condition – The sterling silver shows only light surface wear consistent with age and careful handling. The modelling to the fingers and cuff remains clear and well defined.
