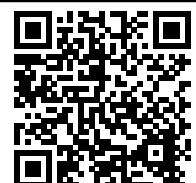
This handsome silver plated table cruet is arranged as a compact stand fitted with matching glass containers and accessories. The arrangement includes: - A faceted glass bottle with a matching stopper, well suited to oil, vinegar, or another table condiment. - A lidded glass jar is fitted with a small spoon aperture in the cover, used for mustard, chutney, or a similar accompaniment. - A perforated topped shaker is included for pepper, caster sugar, or table spice, depending on preference. - A heavy-sided open glass pot sits to the front with a small spoon, ideal for salt, mustard powder, or a small relish. The front of the frame carries an oval plaque engraved with "RAF" beneath a crown within a laurel wreath. The stand is stamped for Walker & Hall of Sheffield, a well-regarded English maker of quality plated wares – circa 1930. Measurements: Height to handle: 6 1/2" (approx. 16.5cm) Width: 6" (approx. 15cm) Depth: 4 1/2" (approx. 11.5cm) Total weight: 789g In good condition – The silver plated frame shows only light surface wear consistent with age. There are no chips or cracks to the glass. The engraved RAF plaque remains clear and visually strong.
