Similar in style to a fancy book chain, this lovely antique necklace is formed of tiny flat coin-like plaques engraved with a scrolling foliate design typical of the Victorian Aesthetic period (c. 1885-1901). **SIZE:** Approximately 18 and a half inches (47cm) long x 1.5cm wide. The tiny "coins" are 9mm diameter. **WEIGHT:** 36.2g. **MATERIALS:** 925 sterling silver. **HALLMARKS/STAMPS:** None found, the silver of the springring clasp and the necklace itself has been tested. **CONDITION:** The piece is in very good antique condition. The silver has a slightly golden cast, it was originally gilded but little remains of the gold now. **ERA:** Victorian (c.1837-1901).
