This is a one off heavy hand crafted terracotta vase and is a very eye catching ceramic work of art from Morocco dating from the 19th Century period being hand thrown in terracotta with a dark cobalt blue finish heavily glazed. This elegant handmade vase features a deep blue navy Moroccan pottery design with a handmade metal sleeve embracing it. Inspired by Moroccan Berber art, it is adorned with flowing, nature-inspired motifs, reflecting the exquisite craftsmanship of Marrakech artisans. This beautifully crafted decorative vase can also be used as a vase with water and flowers inside. This vase was skilfully created by hand shaping the sun-baked terracotta clay on the potter's wheel. Historic designs are etched on the wet clay and dried in the sun. They are then fired in kiln ovens the old fashion way to evaporate the moisture from the clay, cooled, and then decorated with glazes which makes them water-resistant. The outside of this most pleasingly shaped vessel is finished with a decorative silver coloured metal onlay, all carefully worked by hand into shapes circling the top and bottom of the vase w...

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
