Large Superb 18th-Century Oil Portrait Painting - Vicar of Kinver, Staffordshire Brief Description: This is a large, superb and all-original 18th-century Oil on Canvas Portrait Painting depicting the Clergyman and Vicar of Kinver, Paul White (1726 - 1779). The extremely lifelike image portrays the seated clergyman wearing his powdered white clerical wig with traditional Anglican liturgical dress, featuring white linen preaching bands and a black robe. Painted in the style and manner of British artist Thomas Hudson (1701-1779), who was active at the time this portrait was commissioned. Mounted within the huge, original and spectacular quality giltwood and gesso frame. An attached label verso identifies the sitter, together with details relating to his clergy career - see images. Attributes: Oil on Canvas British School Circa: 1770-1775 Condition: The painting is offered in an overall superb original condition and is ready to hang immediately. The huge original frame is in very fine condition.
