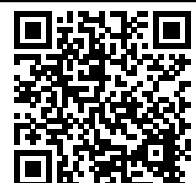

Saint Peter is poised, standing with his religious flagpole in one hand, whilst a young child in a red dress prays before him. It is a magnificent, period Baroque Oil Painting, which is mounted within the outstanding quality 17th-century giltwood carved frame, with elegant mirror segments that run around the length of the frame. It is a very heavy piece, and it is ready to hang immediately.
