P. Gerz, produced in the Westerwald region during the late 19th century. Made in cobalt blue and grey stoneware, these fine vases display deeply modelled high-relief decoration featuring Roman soldiers within a battle setting having ornate designs and heraldic motifs. The Westerwald region has been a centre of German stoneware since the 17th century, and S. P. Gerz became one of its best-known manufacturers, producing high-quality steins, ewers and jugs noted for their crisp relief and distinctive salt-glazed finish. This example reflects the firm's characteristic craftsmanship, with sharply defined modelling and an elegantly formed handles. These striking and substantial antique Ewers stand as a strong example of 19th century German salt glaze work, offering both decorative presence and historical interest to collectors of European ceramics.
