Description

This is a superb example of cut overlaid crystal Bohemian glass. The decanter dates to the turn of the century circa 1895-1900 and is in the style of the two specific producers of luxury glass in this period. Namely Harrach or Josenfinehutte. The manufacturing process was extremely expensive and the glassware was made for the affluent market of the time. The decanter is in superb condition with its original mushroom stopper which has a star cut to emulate the body and base stars. It stands approx 29cm tall. And as it is lead crystal it has a significant weight. The neck of the decanter has oval cuts which actually make it easier to handle and hold to pour. The manufacturing process has a number of stages: initially the single body made from clear lead crystal and this is then overlaid with the coloured glass which is then hand cut to reveal the clear glass. A beautiful and rare object in such pristine condition.
