Pair of late George III cream & polychrome-decorated & parcel gilt armchairs. Each with a top rail centred by an oval tablet painted with cherubs above four acanthus wreaths and a quatrefoil-pierced trellis back. The down-swept arms painted with laurel, the bowed padded seat covered in buttoned crimson red silk with gold braid, on turned tapering reeded legs with turned feet. I wonder if the trellis to the backs was at least partially chosen as it echoes the main field of the Blazon of Cave Baronets of Cleeve Hill Shield as seen in the hyper link below:
