It stands on three gun-barrel sabre-leg bases, the centre section on four outswept legs, the end sections on three legs, all the legs terminating in decoratively embossed brass castors. The underside of each section is stamped '10856', retailed by Whytock & Reid. There is no mistaking the fine craftsmanship of this handsome dining table, which is certain to become a treasured addition to your furniture collection and a talking point with guests at meal times.
