The table is richly decorated with finely cast gilt bronze ormolu mounts, including scrolling foliate ornament, shell motifs, and decorative sabots to the feet. The warm mahogany displays excellent colour and figure throughout, while the graceful proportions and sophisticated design reflect the influence of the finest Parisian furniture makers of the period. A hidden release mechanism beneath the top opens the drawer, demonstrating the quality and attention to detail associated with high-end French cabinetmaking.
