Description

A fine quality 19th century rosewood and parcel gilt music stool or window seat. The upholstered top lifting to reveal a mahogany lined interior, above a frieze with carved swags and paterae front and back. Standing on turned fluted legs united by a wavy flat stretcher with central gilded paterae. The stool bears the label C Nosotti, 398-399, Oxford St, London. The Nosotti's were well known furniture makers with a Royal Warrant (see notes). In fine condition throughout and although made as a duet stool would be good at the foot of a bed, the covering could probably be improved. English Circa 1850.
