A superb and rare H & R Daniel Porcelain Pot Pourri Vase c.1825. The 'U' shaped vase raised on a square pedestal base, with small wavy top rim pierced with small hearts, diamonds and circles, the 2nd rim half repeated with the same pierced design, and a pair of very ornate gilded handles which take the form of an animal's head, the main body decorated with very finely painted summer flowers against a solid gold ground, similar in style to Spode's superb pattern 711. Condition: Good with just a small section of the gallery around the rim restored and a couple of chips to the soccle.
