Description

A fine Wedgwood Fairyland Lustre bowl, York Cup shape, dating from circa 1915 and designed by Daisy Makeig-Jones. The bowl belongs to pattern Z4825, a documented Fairyland design combining Orange Lustre, crimson mottling and Oriental-inspired gilded decoration. The exterior is decorated with a dragon and stylised cloud forms in gold beneath a Greek Key border. The lustre ground displays attractive amber, copper and crimson tones. The interior is finished in Mother-of-Pearl Lustre with deep blue stainings producing a starry appearance. A geometric gilt medallion with Oriental motifs forms the centre of the design, framed by delicate gilded ornament. The underside bears the printed Wedgwood England mark and pattern number Z4825. A highly decorative example from one of the firm's most celebrated early twentieth-century ranges.
