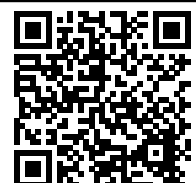

Painted during the 1830s by a follower of the famous Dutch genre painter 'Godfried Schalcken' (1643-1706). Godfried (or Godfrey) Schalcken (1643–1706) was a highly acclaimed Dutch Golden Age painter famous for his masterful use of chiaroscuro and artificial candlelight. Associated with the Leiden fijnschilders (fine painters), he is remembered for his highly polished technique, intimate genre scenes, and as the inspiration for a classic Gothic ghost story. The beautiful image is full of period charm. The piece is mounted within the original, spectacular quality Dutch ripple-moulded ebonised frame, retaining the original presentation plaque with Godfried's details.
