The three principal diamonds totalling 0.89 carats and there is also a small triangular diamond at the tail of approximately 0.1 carats, the setting in the design of the Ace of Clubs. . The fixing pin is straight and strong and has a slide lock. This Art Deco brooch dates from c. 1925 and is in excellent original condition with only very light and fine surface marks consistent with occasional careful use.
