A striking Victorian oil painting on canvas depicting the biblical story of **Daniel in the Lions' Den**, attributed to Staffordshire artist Isaac Findler (1809–1888) and signed and dated 1881. The composition portrays Daniel seated upon a rocky outcrop surrounded by lions yet protected through divine intervention. Dressed in a vivid crimson robe, he gazes heavenward in prayer, creating a powerful image of faith, courage, and spiritual endurance. Executed in oil on canvas, this impressive nineteenth-century religious painting combines strong decorative appeal with historical and devotional significance. The dramatic contrast between the illuminated figure of Daniel and the dark surrounding landscape creates a compelling visual presence. Attributed to Isaac Findler, Isaac Findler was born in 1809 and lived in Cheddleton near Leek, Staffordshire. Although professionally employed as a painter and decorator, he became known locally for producing landscapes and religious subjects.
