The outer body is finely pierced with repeating geometric and rosette-style motifs that allow the glass colour to show through. The piece stands on a stepped pedestal foot with a square plinth base, giving it a confident, architectural presence. The included pierced spoon is well matched for serving sugar, sweetener, or small condiments, and echoes the openwork theme – circa 1905. * A small but distinctive serving piece, perfect for sugar, sweeteners, condiments, or little treats, bringing instant theatre to tea, coffee, and the table.
