This is an impressive large pair of antique George III Neo-classical Robert Adam Revival giltwood mirrors, Circa 1880 in date. This superb pair of carved giltwood mirrors feature oval flower-head paterae crests complimented with decorative side cresting formed of classical urns. Each mirror having a rectangular plate with three panel borders divided by rows of ribbons that drape gracefully down, framed either side by classical columns. A Robert Adam style mirror is a distinctively elegant type of Neoclassical mirror characterized by lightness of form, strict symmetry, and delicate decorations inspired by ancient Roman and Greek architecture. Developed in the late 18th century by the famous Scottish architect and designer Robert Adam, these mirrors moved away from heavy, chunky Baroque and Rococo designs, introducing a much more refined, airy, and "Adamesque" aesthetic.
