Fall front cabinet, dressed with a brass lock escutcheon — in working order, key present. Opening to reveal a suite of arcaded pigeon holes, lidded pen tray and a skiver. Finished in dark blue leather, the skiver is tooled and embossed with some gentle ageing. Replete with a pair of glass ink wells and two calligraphy pens. Graced with a protective baize cushion to the base. This is a striking antique admiral's writing station, with a wonderful appearance and pleasingly useful interior appointment.
