Description

Alexander Jamieson (Scottish, 1873–1937) This painting is a superb, highly characteristic example of early 20th-century British Impressionism, capturing the atmospheric, sun-dappled grandeur of the gardens at Versailles—a deeply favoured subject of the renowned Scottish Impressionist Alexander Jamieson. The oil on board painting centres on an ornate fountain, where sculpted sea-horses rise from the water beneath a classical figurative tier, set against a rich backdrop of warm, autumnal foliage. Executed with Jamieson's characteristically confident, fluid brushwork. Preserved on the reverse is a historical note documenting its direct purchase in 1996 from Miss J. Smith—the companion of Jamieson's daughter, Catherine—straight from the artist's former studio at Weston Turville, Buckinghamshire. Condition: Painting - Very good antique condition, the only thing to note is there appears to be some small scratching to the surface in the bottom right corner.
