Description A rare Edwardian Scottish Whisky advertising glass water carafe dating to c1910. Of Mallet form, it has a three way pouring rim with a flute cut neck. A three way pouring rim with with fluted cutting down the neck. The main body has been enamelled with 'MUNRO'S DALWHINNIE SCOTCH WHISKY', with the name "JAMES MUNRO & SON LTD, DALWHINNIE DISTILLERY, SCOTLAND. Sits on a circular base with a polished pontil.

Date & Origin Scotland, c1910. Period of Edward VII Condition Excellent, age-related wear as shown. The D on DALWHINNIE has lost part of its white enamel showing the engraving below. Outside this, the enamelling is in excellent condition. No chips, cracks or restoration. Some minor internal residue at the very base as shown.

Historical Context Dalwhinnie Distillery, founded in 1897 in the Highlands of Scotland, became well known for producing a lighter Highland malt due in part to its exceptionally high-altitude location and soft mountain water source. James Munro & Son Ltd marketed the whisky under the "Munro's Dalwhinnie" name during the early decades of the 20th century, and surviving branded glass advertising...

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
