The top surfaces remain perfectly flat, completely free from the bowing, twisting, or splitting that often affects pieces made of solid timber from this era. It stands upon beautifully turned, slender legs that epitomise the refined Georgian aesthetic, terminating in their original solid brass cup castors on brass wheels, which retain a magnificent natural patina. The true sophistication and rarity of this piece lie in its ingenious drawer configuration, offering two fully functioning drawer...
