Description

What is particularly attractive about this charming vanity-bag is the wool quality, soft, silky and lustrous, sheared from mountain sheep once a year and used in the very best of Baluch weaving. The main border depicts a continuous flower and vine pattern on a glowing madder-red background. Made circa 1880, the knotted-pile face of the bag is in excellent condition although the plain-weave back has had some hard wear with several small areas of damage. Nevertheless, this shows the bag was once used and was a prized possession among the Baluchis. Size: 34 x 30cm (13" x 12").
