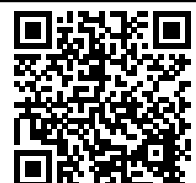
Description

19th C, Pair of Children's, Carved Walnut and Green Leather Chairs (French). After Nicolas-Quinibert Foliot (1706 - 1776), these carved walnut, beechwood caned, and leather seated fauteuils have wide, moulded, cartouche-shaped back with scrolled top rails centred by sprays of marguerites and leaves, with down-curved arms ending in pierced cabochons, leaves and petal- motifs at the handles, the serpentine-fronted caned seat centred by sprays of flowers and leaves repeating those on the top rails, raised on cabriole legs headed by single flower heads and ending in foliate-clad tapering feet. **CONDITION:** Excellent condition. Clearly very well taken care of. **PROVENANCE:** From a Parisian apartment decorated by Daniel Pasgrimaud. Daniel Pasgrimaud considered one of the most talented and reserved decorators of the post-war period, left a significant mark on the field of furniture during the second half of the 20th century.
