He is wearing the style of clothing that was fashionable in Holland during the early to mid 17th century. Clothes and accessories were of enormous importance. Often immense sums were spent on them, and sitters were justifiably proud and anxious to show them off. Their clothes and accessories also carried strong social connotations. Black was the high fashion of that era and this portrait rises to the challenge of painting black on black to depict the floral pattern of the trousers. **JUSTINA VAN TEYLINGEN**, (1596- 1643) [Lady] She was marr...
