The design reflects Lalique's approach to natural motifs, reduced into rhythmic and balanced relief. The contrast between the frosted surface and the more translucent, slightly blue-toned base is characteristic of the model and enhances the sculptural clarity of the decoration. The proportions are well judged, giving the vase a stable and visually confident presence. Marked to the underside "Lalique France", confirming post-1945 production. René Lalique is recognised for redefining decorative glass in the early twentieth century, building on his earlier success in jewellery design. A well-established Lalique model, appreciated for its clarity of form, decorative impact and enduring appeal among collectors of French glass.
