Sheep and lambs are depicted resting on a grassy outcrop high above a valley below. While some of the flock recline peacefully, others gaze across the sweeping landscape. Beyond them, a dramatic mountain range stretches far into the distance enhancing the sense of scale and tranquillity. Robert William Watson was born on 9 March, 1855 at 33 Marlborough Place, Brighton, Sussex the son of William John Watson (1807-1871) and Caroline Butcher. He was part of a family of highland landscape painters and his brothers Charles (1857-1923) and William Watson Jnr (1847-1921) were also artists. His father seems to have travelled around and after spending time in Brighton, the family moved to Bransford Road in Worcester during the early part of the 1860's. Watson and his brothers were taught art by their father who influenced their style and subject matter. In 1880, he married Alice Ascroft at Ormskirk in Lancashire and t...
