Each panel is framed by finely moulded giltwood with delicate Rococo-inspired detailing, the upper glazed sections allowing light to pass through while the lower silk panels provide privacy and decoration. The original bevelled glass and attractive floral silk upholstery complement the refined proportions and graceful French styling. The three hinged sections fold neatly for storage or display and allow the screen to be positioned in a variety of settings. Ideal as a room divider, dressing screen or decorative feature, it would make an elegant addition to a bedroom, drawing room or boutique interior.
