HUGE Magnificent Pair Portrait Oil Paintings 19th-Century Historical Militia Brief Description: This is a huge, magnificent and original matching pair of 19th-century Oil on canvas portrait paintings depicting Major-General Sir Stanley de Astel Calvert Clarke, GCVO, CMG (1837 - 1911), and his wife, Mary Temple Rose, Daughter of Rt. Hon Sir John Rose. The magnificent paintings were executed during the last quarter of the 19th-century by Sir Gerald Festus Kelly KCVO PRA (1879 - 1972). They are extremely lifelike images that portray Major-General Clarke and his wife in a standing three-quarter length pose. He is depicted in ceremonial uniform showcasing several prestigious chivalric orders, including the Order of the Garter (the blue sash across his chest), the Order of the British Empire (GBE), and the Venerable Order of Saint John (GCStJ). She is depicted sporting grey hair, and wearing a white lace veil/headdress and a deep red or orange dress. Each is mounted within its original, huge and impressive giltwood and gesso moulded frame that is embellished with vine and leaves. Signed in the lower left corner, Kelly. Maj.-Gen. Sir Stanley de Astel Calvert Clarke was ...
