The moulded profile edge frames with an inner band of parcel-gilt with trellis incised decoration. Fitted with the original silvered mirror plates and the verso with original back-boards . In excellent original condition, with minor wear to surfaces commensurate with age and use. Smart pair of early C19th small-scale decorative Irish mirrors to bring symmetry and style to an interior scheme . *NB .
