A Lovely Arts And Crafts Tudric pewterware hot drinks pot with a bold, tactile hammered finish. The body has a pleasing ovoid form that sits firmly on a stepped circular foot. A sharply angled, faceted spout gives the design a crisp architectural character. The hinged domed lid is topped with a small thumbpiece. The handle is wrapped in cane or rattan, providing comfortable grip and visual warmth against the metal. The base is clearly stamped "TUDRIC PEWTER WARE" and "MADE IN ENGLAND" with the production number "01373" – circa 1925. * Tudric was the celebrated pewter range retailed by Liberty & Co. of London, and this coffee pot belongs firmly within that Arts and Crafts tradition. Measurements: Height: 6 1/2" (approx. 16.5cm) Width (handle to spout): 6" (approx. 15cm) Total weight: 636g In good condition – The pewter shows only light surface wear consistent with age and gentle handling.

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
