Backrest features a fabulous design of large heraldic shield within a wreath, topped with a crown, held by an eagle and supported by lions, surrounded by scrolling foliage and ribbons. Symmetrical design of foliate forms to the seat. Original large brass studs to the edges. Front legs joined with a carved and shaped stretcher and terminating in large carved feet.
