The 'faux bois or tree and branch' design is a lovely naturalistic casting and this small bench is very comfortable and original with original fixings and solid oak boards. . The paint is many layered and in good condition. There is an area which appears to be a Coalbrookdale stamp but without stripping the paint off it is not possible to confirm and the bench is therefore sold as seen. . There is no significant rust or losses, the bench sits flat and level, is extremely heavy and all joints are tight. It is a very very comfortable seat and a beautiful understated high quality Victorian bench suitable for a smaller garden. . . Dimensions are: . 48.5 inches wide, 22 inches deep and 31.5 inches high. From floor to top of seat is 17.5 inches, seat is 13 inches front to back. Back is 18 inches high from seat.
