A superb canteen of antique Victorian sterling silver cutlery for twelve persons hallmarked in London for 1865 by George Adams. This set has been designed in the fiddle pattern style and sits comfortably in an attractive box with inlaid decoration. It is difficult to find sets from the Victorian era which are original with all the forks and spoons hallmarked in the same year and made by the same silversmith.
