Rich in detail and finely cast, the sculpture beautifully captures the animal's power, grace, and quiet intensity. The lion is depicted advancing confidently on large, powerful clawed paws, his muscular physique rendered with remarkable realism. His expressive face is framed by a full, deeply textured curly mane, while the naturalistic modelling conveys both strength and movement. The bronze is mounted on its original pale green figured onyx plinth, which provides an elegant contrast to the rich patinated bronze. The underside retains its original suede leather lining, protecting polished surfaces while reflecting the quality of the piece's original finish. The bronze is presented in excellent antique condition with an attractive age-related patina.
