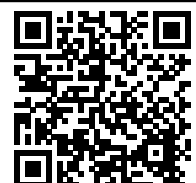

The optics are clear and fully functional, providing excellent viewing performance, while the sliding front barrel forms an integrated sunshade to reduce glare in bright conditions. The telescope is beautifully finished with a finely stitched tan leather covering, complementing the quality craftsmanship synonymous with British military optical instruments of the period. It is fully signed by Broadhurst & Clarkson Ltd. and bears the British military broad arrow acceptance mark, confirming its military provenance.
