A small 18th century English cabinet on stand constructed from walnut, fruitwood and mahogany. The cabinet is decorated with ebony veneered diamonds on the front and sides and consists of two doors which open to reveal an array of drawers with the largest central drawer having a secret compartment in the back and also inlaid inside the arcade with a crucifix, which would indicate that this may have been used in a vestry at some stage. Below the drawers is an open compartment which is ideal for paperwork or even your modern day laptop. The stand has a single drawer and four cabriole legs on pad feet. The cabinet has lovely colour and patination to the timber, there is some areas that have old wood worm and a few old repairs commensurate with age, but overall this is in good condition and is ready for use.
