The leather is finished with a hand-applied brass studded trim that highlights the sweeping lines of the arms and seat. The generously padded armrests are supported by turned oak columns, echoing the classical influence of the design. The front legs are beautifully carved in the traditional Victorian manner and terminate in solid brass castors for ease of movement, while the rear legs remain straight and sturdy. These chairs combine period authenticity with contemporary comfort and would make a distinguished addition to any library, study, or drawing room.
