Working within the strong German animalier tradition, she specialised particularly in studies of dogs, which were modelled with notable anatomical accuracy and sympathetic characterisation. Her works were typically cast in bronze and finished with rich brown patination, often depicting breeds such as terriers and other domestic dogs in alert or naturalistic stances.
