An acid resist landscape was painted free-hand onto the vessel which was then etched by plunging into a hydrofluoric acid bath. The outer surface was then polished which gave the trees a 'third dimension' as the onlooker can see through the clear glass to the inner colour. Then the background was frosted,...
