The walnut has developed a very good colour and really decent patina. . Substantial and very pretty, the stool has been recently re-upholstered in a good quality linen mix fabric with a pale cream ground and embroidered green leaf with gold pattern. . Well padded, heavy, robust and very comfortable. . The spiral turned legs terminating in large and original bun feet, the legs united with spiral turned stretchers which meet at a central shaped dais with turned finial above. . So pretty and practical and a very handsome mid 19th century solid walnut stool that will look good and provide good service for generations to come. . No worm or repairs or significant dings or scuffs. . Very striking and usable with lovely well balanced proportions – strongly recommended. .
