A handsome English late Georgian mahogany chest of drawers dating to circa 1810, of compact and highly usable proportions. The chest is arranged in the classic configuration of two short drawers over three long graduating drawers, all retaining attractive figured mahogany fronts with cockbeaded detailing. The rich grain and warm colour create an appealing surface with the mellow patina expected from a piece of this age. Fitted with brass oval plate handles and retaining a working key. Raised on bracket feet with pleasing clean lines typical of the Georgian period. A practical and decorative antique chest offering excellent storage and equally suited to a bedroom, hall, sitting room or study. Condition: Presented in good antique condition with age-related wear, marks and minor imperfections consistent with over two centuries of use. Drawers run as expected and key is present and working.
