Description

A finely detailed cold-painted bronze of a saddled horse demonstrating the refined craftsmanship associated with the Vienna workshop of Franz Bergman. The horse stands alert and poised, its elegant proportions and naturalistic modelling capturing both strength and quiet composure. Subtle variations in the warm brown patina enhance the musculature, while the delicately painted saddle and bridle add a note of realism and charm. Signed with the Bergman "B" and marked "gesch"—an abbreviation of Geschützt, indicating a registered design—the piece reflects both artistic quality and authenticity. The careful balance of form, colour, and detail makes this sculpture a distinguished example of early 20th-century Viennese bronze artistry.
