Early Scottish seating of this calibre is exceptionally scarce - and to find a matched pair is rarer still. These chairs have that unmistakable mid-17th century authority: upright, architectural, and quietly powerful. The later velvet upholstery softens the austerity of the oak, while the applied armorial crests add a ceremonial, almost theatrical presence. They feel like chairs that have witnessed important conversations, clan gatherings, and moments of significance. They carry gravitas without being overbearing - dignified, evocative, and steeped in identity and tradition.
