A herd of sheep with lambs are depicted resting on the side of a mountain overlooking Loch Tay. One of the sheep is shown gazing out across the still expanse of the loch towards the dramatic mountains beyond, while the rest of the flock repose quietly among the heather and gorse in the softening evening light. The composition captures both the calm of the Highland landscape and the quiet presence of the animals within it. Loch Tay is a freshwater loch in the central highlands and is the largest body freshwater in Perth and Kinross. The peaks that provide the backdrop to the loch include the Ben Lawers Range on the northside and the Tarmachan Ridge to the west/northwest. William Watson was born in Islington in 1847, the son of the London miniature painter William John Watson (1810-1871) and his wife Caroline (née Butcher). His brothers C...
