Raised on slender turned and tapering legs , the rectangular top fitted with a single 'cock-beaded' frieze drawer retaining it's original turned mahogany knob pulls and blue paper lining . The other three friezes having faux or 'dummy' drawer fronts with corresponding 'cock-beaded' fronts and all retaining their matching original turned mahogany knobs, all providing perfect symmetry to the table . The rectangular figured mahogany top having a slight overhang to the frame with a plain edge . In excellent original condition with no damage or repairs with a rich colour and patina .
